

ORDINANCE NO. 654

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE FILLING OF
GOVERNING BODY VACANCIES IN THE CITY OF ROSE HILL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSE
HILL, KANSAS:


Section 1. As used in this section, the term "Governing body" shall include the mayor and members of the city council.

Section 2. If a vacancy in the governing body has not been filled in accordance with Charter Ordinance No. 13 of the City of Rose Hill within 60 days of the vacancy, then the governing body, by a majority vote of the remaining members, may pass a resolution calling for a special election to fill such vacancy to be held within 45 days of the passage of such resolution. Candidates for the vacant office shall file for such office as provided in K.S.A. 25- 2110a, and amendments thereto. The special election shall be conducted by the county election officer. The candidate receiving the highest number of votes for the vacant position shall assume such office upon certification of the election results.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after its passage and publication in the official city newspaper.



