

## **City of Rose Hill Strategic Planning Process 2013-2014**

At the direction of the city council, the community of Rose Hill and the Hugo Wall School of Urban and Public Affairs at Wichita State University are working to develop a strategic plan for the community. The process will assist the City of Rose Hill with citizen participation; issue identification, prioritization, development of goals, objectives and strategies; and a planning document.

### **PURPOSE**

The plan will create a roadmap for the City of Rose Hill to guide future policy priorities and decisions. This document will help guide the city's financial decisions, quality of life and potential growth issues.

### **PROCESS**

The first stages of the process involve a city council-appointed steering committee and listening tours with various community groups (schools, senior citizens, business community, city council members, historical society, faith community, city employees). Input from the public meeting held on January 9, 2014 will contribute to the upcoming steering committee work and the development of the final plan which we anticipate will be presented to the city council in May.

For those who were unable to attend the Public Open House, the following are survey questions that will be sent out in the February 1, 2014 water/sewer bills:

**Area 1 Questions:      Using three words, describe the community of Rose Hill now.**

**What do you value most about your community?**

**Area 2 Question:      What are the community's challenges?**

**Area 3 Question:      What opportunities are possible for the community?**

**Area 4 Question:      What words best describe what you want to see or experience in Rose Hill 5 years from now?**
