- Must be 18 year old, or be supervised by an adult.
- Coordinate schedule for flags to be displayed, notifying the City of any changes in the schedule.
- Hang and remove all flags in accordance with the schedule established.
- Storage will be the responsibility of club.
- Any labor incurred or damage caused to poles will be reimbursed to the City.
- Flags must be removed within 24 hours of event.
- Remove as soon as possible any flag that has become vandalized or defaced, reporting incident to both the Police Department and the Public Works Department.

#### City responsibilities

The City agrees to the following responsibilities:

- Coordinate schedule of flags to be displayed with Gridiron Club.
- City is not liable for any damages to Gridiron flags.
- City will have first choice in schedule of flags if conflict in schedule arises.
- Acquire and maintain all brackets necessary for hanging flags.
- City has the right to ask that flags be removed for any reason.
- City has the right to terminate M.O.U. at any time.

WHEREAS, the City of Rose Hill, Kansas (the Municipality) has entered into a Loan Agreement with the Kansas Department of Health and Environment, acting on behalf of the State of Kansas, effective as of December 8, 2017 (the "Loan Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, said Loan Agreement was entered into for the benefit of the Municipality, KWPCRF Project No. C20 2023 01; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality and KDHE hereby determines that it is necessary to amend certain exhibits to the Loan Agreement, and

WHEREAS, this Second Amendment to the Loan Agreement is entered into and effective as of July 17, 2018;

THEREFORE, the Loan Agreement is amended as follows:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Article II, Loan Terms, Section 2.01, <u>Amount of Loan</u> and Exhibit B of the LOAN AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT AND THE CITY OF ROSE HILL, KANSAS are hereby amended to read as set forth on the pages attached hereto.

SECTION 2. Except as herein specifically set out, the Loan Agreement is confirmed and ratified.

#### ARTICLE II

#### LOAN TERMS

Section 2.01. Amount of the Loan. Subject to all of the terms, provisions and conditions of this Loan Agreement, and subject to the availability of State and Federal funds, KDHE will loan an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Eighteen Dollars [\$408,718] Three Hundred Ninety Two Thousand Two Hundred Forty Eight Dollars Three Cents [\$392,248.03] to the Municipality to pay the costs of the Project described in Exhibit A hereto. The final actual amount of the Loan may be reduced without revision of any other terms, provisions or conditions of this Loan Agreement, other than the Loan Repayment Schedule (Exhibit B hereto), to reflect reductions in the estimated or actual total Project Costs as impacted by opening of bids for construction, change orders, final actual costs, and prepayments. The Municipality shall be responsible for any costs incurred by the Municipality in connection with the Project in addition to the amount of the Loan. An amendment to Exhibit B must be accomplished by an Amendment to the Loan Agreement executed by all parties.

#### DEDICATED SOURCE OF REVENUES AND LOAN REPAYMENT SCHEDULE

#### Dedicated Source of Revenue.

The Municipality shall impose and collect such rates, fees and charges for the use and services furnished by or through the System, including all improvements and additions thereto hereafter constructed or acquired by the Municipality as will provide System Revenues or levy ad valorem taxes without limitation as to rate or amount upon all the taxable tangible property, real or personal, within the territorial limits of the Municipality to produce amounts which are sufficient to (a) pay the cost of the operation and maintenance of the System, (b) pay the principal of and interest on the Loan as and when the same become due, and (c) pay all other amounts due at any time under the Loan Agreement; provided, however, no lien or other security interest is granted by the Municipality to KDHE on the System Revenues under this Agreement. In the event that the System Revenues are insufficient to meet the obligations under the Loan and the Loan Agreement, the Municipality shall levy ad valorem taxes without limitation as to rate or amount upon all the taxable tangible property, real or personal, within the territorial limits of the Municipality to produce the amounts necessary for the prompt payment of the obligations under the Loan and Loan Agreement.

#### The Loan Repayment Schedule

The Municipality and KDHE have agreed that interest becoming due semiannually on the Loan during the construction period for the Project may be capitalized and repaid as a part of the Loan. In this regard, KDHE shall give the Municipality written notice of each semiannual installment of interest becoming due during the construction period. At its option, the Municipality may elect to pay such amounts, and if so elected, must pay such amounts within 30 days of receipt of the notice of their becoming due. If the Municipality does not elect to pay such amounts within 30 days of receipt of such notice, the amount then due and owing as semiannual interest on the Loan shall be capitalized and added to the principal amount of the Loan and shall bear interest at the rate of interest set forth in Section 2.02 hereof.
