

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSE HILL, KANSAS TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX RATE EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE;

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for the City of Rose Hill was calculated as 44.870 mills by the Butler County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, on August 12th, the City of Rose Hill published notice of its proposed intent to exceed the revenue neutral rate including its proposed tax rate of 47.000; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of the City of Rose Hill will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body held a hearing on Tuesday, September 7, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. allowing all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard an opportunity to give oral testimony; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Rose Hill, having heard testimony, still finds it necessary to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSE HILL, KANSAS:

The City of Rose Hill, Kansas shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 44.870 mills but not to exceed the proposed tax rate provided in the notice published on August 12th, 2021.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Governing Body.
