A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY FOR ACQUIRING PRIVATE PROPERTY FOR THE USE OF THE CITY OF ROSE HILL IN CONNECTION WITH THE 2019 STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FOR MORRIS, COX, AND SMITH IN THE CITY OF ROSE HILL, BUTLER COUNTY, KANSAS;

WHEREAS, the governing body has previously authorized the study and the preliminary design of certain improvements for the 2019 Street Improvement project for Morris, Cox, and Smith in the City of Rose Hill; and

WHEREAS, such study and preliminary design has identified the need to acquire temporary and permanent easements of private property in order to properly complete such improvements; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSE HILL, KANSAS;

SECTION 1. The governing body hereby declares it to be necessary to acquire certain private property in connection with construction of the 2019 street improvement project for Cox, Morris and Smith;

SECTION 2. The City Administrator is authorized to have a professional survey completed with the description of the lands and/or interests to be acquired and to file the same with the City Clerk.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication once in the official City paper.
