## RESOLUTION NUMBER 656

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REPLACEMENT OF PUMPS AND RELATED INSTALLATION OF RELATED EQUIPMENT AT THE AT THE ROSE HILL WATER BOOSTER STATION AND UTILIZING THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS THROUGH THE LOSS REVENUE CALCULATION.

WHEREAS, City of Rose Hill has and will receive funds from the America Rescue Plan Act (ARPA); and,

WHEREAS, final rules have been established for the ARPA funds; and,

**WHEREAS,** the City of Rose Hill has made efforts to receive guidance on the ARPA program and to commit funding consistent with best practices and based upon interim regulations, rules, and guidance; and,

**WHEREAS,** the City of Rose Hill has submitted its estimated revenue loss to their contracted auditor and he has concurred with the estimated revenue calculated for 2021; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Rose Hill needs to replace booster pumps at the water pumping station that are approximately 22 years old and the original ARPA budget for the project was \$75,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the pumps were installed in a manner that makes only same brand pumps compatible with the existing piping system as City has contacted other suppliers but their models would require extensive piping and control modifications, extending the time necessary to replace the pumps and increase cost; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed pumps will be Variable Frequency Drive, improving the consistent pressure of the water system, limiting "hammering" within the system, and having increased energy efficiency; and,

**BE IT RESOLVED THAT,** the City of Rose Hill authorizes the purchase of materials, equipment, and installation per ESI quote number DKB22522 rev1 dated August 16, 2022, in the amount of \$63,347.00. There will be additional costs for SCADA controls to be determined between the City, ESI and R.E. Pedrotti, the SCADA control contractor for the City of Rose Hill for additional work and shall budget up to \$5,000.00 in loss of revenue funds from ARPA funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** the City Council of Rose Hill, Kansas, has considered, discussed, and adopts this Resolution on the use of loss of revenue as authorized under ARPA regulations and shall utilize loss of revenue funds/ARPA in the amount not to exceed \$68,347.00 and previous resolutions in conflict with this action are considered void and shall be effective adoption and shall be filed with the City Clerk.
