Ordinance No. 711

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT ON CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE CITY OF ROSE HILL, KANSAS, UNDER THE AUTHORITY GRANTED BY THE ZONING REGULATIONS OF THE CITY.

Be it ordained by the governing body of the City of Rose Hill, Kansas:

Section 1. Having received a recommendation from the Rose Hill City Planning Commission on Case No. Z-2023-02, and proper notice having been given and hearing held as provided by law and under authority and subject to the provisions of the Zoning Regulations of the City as originally approved by Ordinance 661, a Conditional Use Permit to allow Self-Storage facilities utilizing storage containers in "B-1" Local Business District is approved by the City of Rose Hill, Kansas, for the following:

Legal Description: (A complete legal description is available for public inspection which is on file with the Zoning Administrator at City Hall). A portion of Lots 4 and 9, Block 1, Heritage Addition, a replat of a portion of Sunnyview Addition to the City of Rose Hill, Butler County, Kansas, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of Lot 4, Block 1, Heritage Addition; thence with a bearing North 69 degrees 15' 46" East (basis of bearing NAD 83 Kansas South Zone) along the South line of said Lot 4 a distance of 35.00 feet; thence North 00 degrees 03' 34" West parallel with the West line of said Lots 4 and 9 a distance of 458.77 feet to the North line of said Lot 9; thence North 47 degrees 39' 19" East along the North line of said Lot 9 a distance of 145.50 feet; thence South 00 degrees 06' 57" East along the East line of said Lot 4 and the extension thereof a distance of 555.39 feet to the Southeast corner of said Lot 4; thence South 89 degrees 15' 46" West along the South line of said Lot 4 a distance of 108.20 feet to the point of beginning containing 1.257 Acres subject to any easements and restrictions of record.

General Description: 210 N. Main – Rose Hill, Kansas.

<u>Section 2.</u> Upon the taking effect of this ordinance, the above Conditional Use Permit shall be adopted and maintained on file.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication once in the official city newspaper.
