



Green Waste Site Rules and Regulations

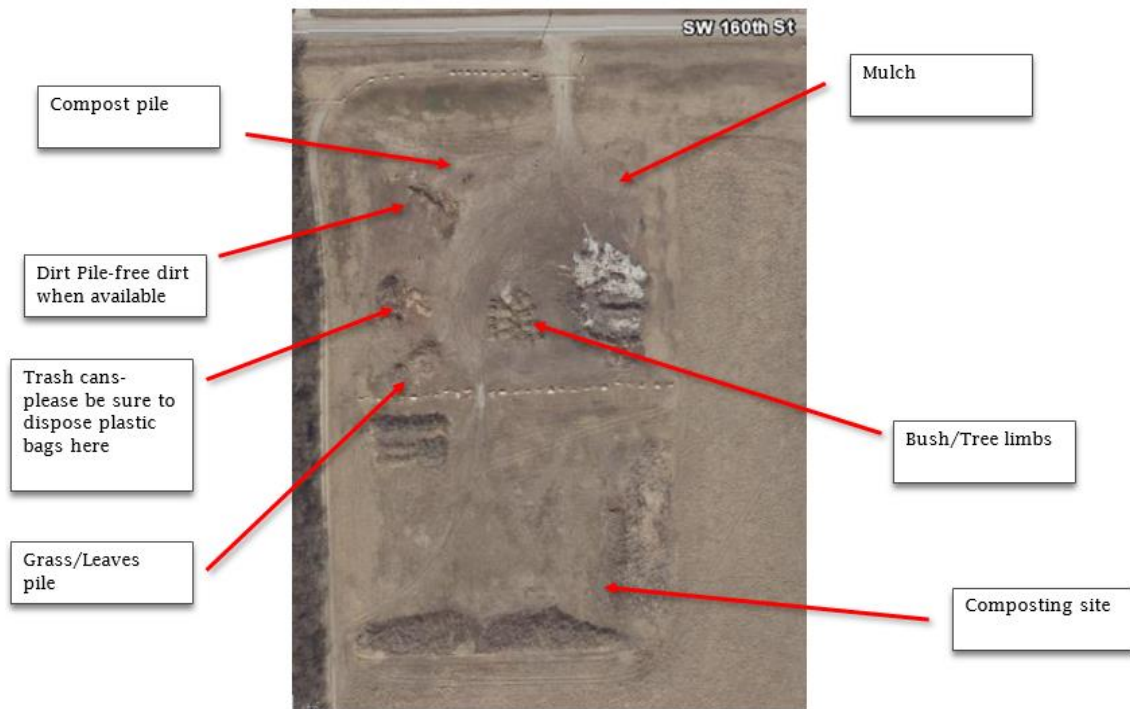
Rose Hill residents may drop off their residential yard waste (grass clippings, tree limbs and miscellaneous vegetation debris) at the Green Waste site. Residents are also allowed to take any available dirt or mulch at the site for no charge.

To access the site, the Rose Hill resident who is responsible for the utility bill may pick up a key fob at City Hall (applicant must have a utility account paid to date and a valid Driver's License for address verification). The first fob is free and must be returned to City Hall if resident were to move from city limits (a \$25 will apply if not returned, lost or damaged). After the key fob has been acquired, the Rose Hill resident may take their yard waste to the Green Waste site any day of the week between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m.

Lending the key fob to a non-resident is not permitted. Any violation of the Green Waste Site Rules and Regulations may result in suspension.

DISCLAIMER: The Green Waste site will still close due to weather or routine maintenance. It is the discretion of the City of Rose Hill to close the site or suspend use of a fob.

Location: 15385 SW 160th St, near the City's Wastewater Treatment plant. The city has approximately five (5) acres dedicated to Green Waste divided according to the following diagram:



Materials Accepted: Grass Clippings, leaves, flower & garden trimmings, branches, limbs (up to 3-inches MAXIMUM in diameter).

Material NOT Accepted: Logs, tree stumps (**OVER** 3-inches in diameter), building materials of any kind, hazardous waste, rocks, bricks, plastic bags, garbage, household trash, processed wood products and tires. **NO COMMERCIAL DUMPING! Violators will be prosecuted for trespassing and subject to fine of \$1,000.00/6 months (UPOC #6-6.7. KSA #32-1013). VIDEO SURVEILLANCE HAS BEEN INSTALLED AT THE SITE AND WILL BE MONITORED.**
