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Water Protection Fee (WPF)

The WPF is collected by public water suppliers for the State of Kansas – the fee is \$0.032 per 1,000 gallons of water usage.

Water Account Set Up Fee/ Reconnection Fee

- Each resident shall pay a non-refundable \$50.00 account set-up fee to establish service.
- Should service be terminated for non-payment, a fee of \$50.00 will be charged for the turning off and on of service.

Sewer Improvement Fee

Flat rate of \$29.33 per customer, per month – This was implemented to pay the debt for construction of a mechanical wastewater treatment facility that was mandated by the State of Kansas (started in May 2007 and will be in place for 20 years).

Sewer

New resident rate is \$20.53 for one year, until an average is calculated. For established residents, the water usage during the months of December, January, February, and March are averaged to create the annual sewer rate for the year.
