RESOLUTION NO. 702

**A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THE ADVISABILITY OF MAKING CERTAIN
INTERNAL IMPROVEMENTS IN THE CITY OF ROSE HILL, KANSAS;
MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS WITH RESPECT THERETO; AND
AUTHORIZING AND PROVIDING FOR THE MAKING OF THE
IMPROVEMENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUCH FINDINGS (WATER
IMPROVEMENTS-PHASE 3/SUNRISE ADDITION).**

WHEREAS, a petition (the “Petition”) was filed with the City Clerk of the City of Rose Hill, Kansas (the “City”) proposing certain internal improvements; and said Petition sets forth: (a) the general nature of the proposed improvements; (b) the estimated or probable cost of the proposed improvements; (c) the extent of the proposed improvement district to be assessed for the cost of the proposed improvements; (d) the proposed method of assessment; (e) the proposed apportionment of the cost between the improvement district and the City-at-large; and (f) a request that such improvements be made without notice and hearing as required by K.S.A. 12-6a01 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City hereby finds and determines that said Petition was signed by the owners of record of more than one-half of the area liable for assessment for the proposed improvements, and is therefore sufficient in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 12-6a01 *et seq.* (the “Act”).

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSE HILL, KANSAS:

Section 1. Findings of Advisability. The governing body hereby finds and determines that:

(a) It is advisable to make the following improvements (the “Improvements”):

Construct water distribution improvements to serve the area described as the Improvement District, all in accordance with City standards and plans and specifications prepared or approved by the City Engineer.

(b) The estimated or probable cost of the proposed Improvements is: \$359,000, said estimated cost to be increased at the pro rata rate of 1 percent per month from and after the date of adoption of this Resolution.

(c) The extent of the improvement district (the “Improvement District”) to be assessed for the cost of the Improvements is:

Lots 12 through 21, Block A; Lots 9 through 12, Block B; Lots 7 through 14, and Lots 34 through 38, Block E; and Lots 15 through 17, Block G, Sunrise Addition to the City of Rose Hill, Butler County, Kansas.

(d) The method of assessment is: equally per lot (30 lots). Where the ownership of a single lot is or may be divided into two or more parcels, the assessment to the lot so divided shall be assessed to each ownership or parcel on a square foot basis.

(e) The apportionment of the cost of the Improvements between the Improvement District and the City-at-large is: 100% to be assessed against the Improvement District and 0% to be paid by the City-at-large.

Section 2. Authorization of Improvements. The abovesaid Improvements are hereby authorized and ordered to be made in accordance with the findings of the governing body of the City as set forth in **Section 1** of this Resolution.

Section 3. Bond Authority; Reimbursement. The Act provides for the costs of the Improvements, interest on interim financing and associated financing costs to be paid by the issuance of general obligation bonds or special obligation bonds of the City (the "Bonds"). The Bonds may be issued to reimburse expenditures made on or after the date which is 60 days before the date of this Resolution, pursuant to Treasury Regulation 1.150-2.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption. This Resolution shall be published one time in the official City newspaper, and shall also be filed of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Butler County, Kansas.

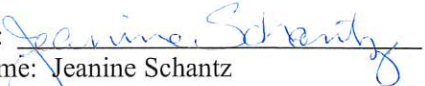
